AYER KEROH – If things go as plan, Melaka will make its name into the Malaysia Books of Records when the longest bubur lambuk is prepared for the month of Ramadan.

The record-breaking attempt will be carried out on July 18 at Hang Tuah Mall here involving various participants.

Ghazale Muhamad, the record-breaking attempt will be participated by the Melaka Hotel Associations (MAH) with the support from the Tourism and Culture Ministry and Tourism Malaysia.

He said all hotels and other agencies in the state are invited to be part of the record-breaking attempt.

"A total of 20,000 bowls of bubur lambuk are expected to be prepared

and distributed to the public, including orphans and road users," he added.

He told reporters this after distributing bubur lambuk prepared by the Philea Resort and Spa to road users at the Ayer Keroh Toll Plaza here. A total of 7,000 bowls of bubur lambuk were distributed during the annual event, the forth to be held by the resort.
